

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
MAY 4, 2006

The Board of Mayor and Commissioners met in regular session. The following members were present: Commissioner Buford Goolsby, Commissioner Keith Durham, Commissioner Butch Morrow, and Commissioner Tim Dickey. Mayor Allen Chapman was absent.

With a quorum present, Vice Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Morrow made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 20<sup>th</sup> meeting, with a second by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

City Administrator Terrell Sellers presented the Commission a draft of the 2006-2007 budget with the numbers based upon facts as we know them today. They are to meet next Tuesday at 5:00 p.m. for budget discussions.

Mr. Sellers asked the Commission to meet on Wednesday, May 10<sup>th</sup> to visit South End Manufacturing and inspect the equipment of the Street and Sanitation Department, for budgetary reasons.

Mr. Sellers also informed the Commission that Mr. Joe Baxter will give a quarterly report on storm water next meeting.

Commissioner Dickey requested a review of the speed limit question at Dunn Community.

Commissioner Morrow presented some ideas from the Litter Committee on household litter. The Commission asked for copies of ordinances pertaining to litter and will conduct a study on the situation and possible solutions.

Attorney Betz presented four resolutions for the Commission's consideration.

Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Morrow, with a second by Commissioner Goolsby. Motion passed unanimously.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG TO AUTHORIZE MAYOR ALLEN CHAPMAN TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR FEDERAL AND STATE SURPLUS PROPERTY PROGRAM.

Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Dickey, with a second by Commissioner Morrow. Motion passed unanimously.

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO APPOINT ROBERT PARKER AS THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG'S REPRESENTATIVE ON THE EQUALIZATION BOARD.

Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Goolsby, with a second by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

TO CONVEY PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG,  
TENNESSEE FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE LAWRENCEBURG  
UTILITY SYSTEMS AND TO EXECUTE NOTICE THAT PETROLEUM  
WASTES ARE PRESENT PURSUANT TO RULE 1200-1-7-.04(8) (g) 7 OF  
THE TENNESSEE RULE CHAPTER 1200-1-7
