

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
JANUARY 18, 2007

The Board of Mayor and Commissioners met in regular session. The following members were present: Commissioner Butch Morrow, Commissioner Tim Dickey, Mayor Chapman and Commissioner Goolsby. Commissioner Keith Durham was absent.

With a quorum present, Mayor Chapman called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the January 4, 2007 meeting was made by Mayor Chapman, with a second by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Ken West with Faith Recovery Center addressed the Commission on the mission of his organization to find a house or houses in the City of Lawrenceburg for a drug and alcohol treatment center. He would like their input on where such property may be located and asked permission to call upon the Police Department for assistance, should a problem develop at the center.
