A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE, TO ACCEPT THE BID OF BRINDLEE MOUNTAIN FIRE APPARATUS, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$615,000.000 (SIX HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS) FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE MID MOUNT AERIAL FIRE TRUCK FOR USE BY THE LAWRENCEBURG FIRE DEPARTMENT
