

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

August 25, 2016

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Sevier, Council Member Williams, and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the August 11, 2016 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Williams second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

Melita and Skip Massey were in attendance and the Mayor asked them to make an announcement.
