

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

June 12, 2014

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Moore, Council Member Sevier and Council Member Williams.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the May 22, 2014 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham introduced Jay Piovarcy.

Mr. Piovarcy spoke to the Council concerning the addition of a soccer field that would be divided into two fields. He would like to take the current parking area to make the field and create more parking on an area that presently holds lots of water. He indicated that top soil would be donated.

Mayor Durham asked City Administrator, Chris Shaffer to talk to the School Board and for Griggs and Maloney; City Engineers also take a look at the request.

City Administrator, Chris Shaffer, informed the Council that Keith Kennedy will be here at 1 PM to look at Babe Ruth Park and discuss the bleachers for the park. He also thanked Judy Hartsfield and local merchants for their work and contributions to the City Health Fair.

A work session for the 2014-15 fiscal year budget is scheduled for Monday 4:30 pm.

The Lawrence County Sheriff's Department donated an old Crown Vic to the Lawrenceburg Fire Department and Mashburn Collision painted it for free. So our fire department has a new vehicle for practically nothing. It will need new tires in the near future.

EMA Director, Joe Baxter gave a report on the recent rain events in the county and surrounding area. The flood control project is working. We still have more work to do, but I am proud of the progress we have made, especially with fewer streets becoming flooded and impassable.

LUS Financials were received and accepted for April 2014.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Sevier, with a second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

A RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG TO ACCEPT BID AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH ROGERS GROUP FOR ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS TO REMKE STREET AND HELTON DRIVE IN THE LAWRENCEBURG INDUSTRIAL PARK WITH RESPECT TO THE 2011 APPALICIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION GRANT

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

A RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO REAPPOINT JERRY JONES TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

Will Owen with Griggs and Maloney gave the Council a report on Springer Road and Weakley Creek Road. Both streets were proof rolled and there are some soft spots on Springer. To do spot repairs, cold mill surface and repave would cost approximately \$340,000.00; there are some drainage issues with Springer.

Weakley Creek Road to hot mix with 1 ½ inch overlay from Springer to Sundance, cost would be approximately \$166,000.00.

With no further business to come before the Council a motion was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Williams.
