

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

October 22, 2015

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Sevier, Council Member Williams and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2015 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Steve Frisbie and Mike Crane spoke to the Council concerning building an indoor hitting and pitching facility for LCHS and asked for any requirements to modify the lease to do so.

City Administrator, Chris Shaffer thanked Judy Hartsfield for her work on the Health Fair for employees and spoke on upcoming events at Crockett Theater; the Parks Department Halloween Party; and that CGI Video is here working on films for our web site and seeking advertisements.
