

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

September 11, 2014

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Williams, Council Member Sevier and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the August 28, 2014 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

City Administrator, Chris Shaffer, informed the Council of the 9-11 Memorial Service this evening at 7 pm sponsored by Main Street and Fire Fighters Association. Blake Grooms and Sam McConnell are in Nashville receiving the Homeland Security, District 8 First Responder Award for their role in the CVS robbery. Joe Baxter is working on emergency training for the Department Managers and other personnel in case we have an emergency such as ice storm or tornado. Our current debt collector Solutia has closed and we are looking for another company.

LUS Financials for June, 2014 were received.

Public Hearing was opened on Ordinance 1144; with no one wishing to address the Council concerning the Fiscal Year 2014/2015 Budget, the Public Hearing closed.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham asked Fire Chief Jay Moore to expound on the 9-11 Memorial Service this evening.

Mayor Durham asked Council Member Moore (a member of Rotary Club) about the fair. He stated it was coming September 22.

Mayor Durham also asked Director of Public Works, Jerry Smith, if all the paving at the improvements at Rotary Park had been done and he indicated that it is finished.
