

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

April 22, 2021

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The meeting was also held by teleconference. The following members were present: Council Member Sevier, Council Member Fox, Council Member Williams, Mayor Lay and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 24, 2021 Council Meeting and the April 12, Special Called Meeting was made by Council Member Fox with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Lay spoke about the College Inaugural Ceremony and how fortunate our community is to have this facility. It began six years ago and Martin Methodist Dean, said we have done our part and now it is up to them to get students enrolled.

A groundbreaking for the Animal Shelter was held this week, and it is a community and government project. It is going to be a facility that is really nice and will be a great addition to our community.
