

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

February 25, 2021

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The meeting was also held by teleconference. The following members were present: Council Member Sevier, Council Member Fox, Mayor Lay and Council Member Moore. Council Member Williams was absent

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the February 11, 2021 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Fox with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG TO ACCEPT THE BID FROM KENT CARVELL CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. AND EXECUTE CHANGE ORDERS FOR THE LAWRENCEBURG ANIMAL SHELTER PROJECT

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Sevier, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.
