CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
March 9, 2023

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session.

The following members were present: Council Member Williams, Council Member Moore, and Council Member Sevier, and Mayor Lay. Council Member Fox was absent.

With a quorum present the Mayor called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
