

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

May 10, 2018

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Council Member Williams, Council Member Moore and Mayor Durham. Council Member Sevier was absent.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the April 26, 2018 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

City Administrator informed the Council that work on the budget has begun.

Police Chief, Terry Beecham, updated the Council on the Fun Run for E. O. Coffman School scheduled for May 11. It will begin at approximately 8:00 p.m. They will be crossing Highway 64 (East Gaines) several times and the County Officers will help control traffic at Springer Road and Lafayette Avenue. There will be adults, children and possibly dogs etc. Traffic may want to avoid the Admiral Circle Subdivision area until after 9:30 p.m.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND OTHER VEHICLES ON LAFAYETTE AVENUE AND PULASKI STREET IN FRONT OF AND NEAR E. O. COFFMAN SCHOOL DURING CERTAIN HOURS WHEN SCHOOL IS IN SESSION WITH EXCEPTION AFTER REGULAR SCHOOL HOURS AND THE NO PARKING ANY TIME SIGNS – Second Reading.
